## “How 2 Share Your Faith”



“I Will Tell The World What God Has Done For Me!”



“Go into all the world and preach the good news...”  
– Mark 16:15

This week, we continue in our series, “How 2,” and we’re learning that it is OUR job to reach out to those around us who do not know Jesus. We must share God’s love with them, praying and believing that they will accept His love and forgiveness just as we have. The Apostle Paul gives us a great example of how we can share our faith with others!

### Read:

Acts 17:13-34

### Ask:

- What did Paul notice when he walked around Athens, Greece?
- What did Paul decide to do about it?
- What did Paul say about the “Unknown God”?
- How did the crowd of people respond to Paul sharing his faith?

### Say:

Paul knew that everyone needed to hear about Jesus and what He has done for them. Paul knew that every soul matters to God. When he saw what was going on in Athens, Greece, he was discouraged and saddened. He knew he needed to tell those people about Jesus so that they would at least have the opportunity to know the truth, turn from their sin, and follow Him. That’s exactly what we need to do, too! Our world is full of sin and it is our responsibility to share our faith in Jesus with everyone we know!

### Ask/Discuss:

- Where are some places you go every day that people need to hear about Jesus?
- What are some ways you can share your faith with others?
- What do you do if you share your faith with someone and they don’t immediately start following Jesus?

### Pray:

Pray that your children will have the courage and the boldness to share their faith with everyone they know. Pray that, as a result, lost people come to know Jesus!
