“How 2 Survive A Storm”



“Storms May Come & Storms May Go, But God Is With Me – This I Know!”



“...O Lord...you are a refuge from the storm...” - Isaiah 25:4

This week, in our series, “How 2”, we find out that life is full of storms! Crazy, unexpected, and difficult circumstances often come up in our lives, and we need to know how to face them. We look at the story of Paul who was being held prisoner on a ship that sailed into a huge storm, and we find out that we don’t have to face our storms alone! If we have faith, we can make it through the storm!

Read:

Acts 27:20-26

Ask:

- How were the soldiers and the crew on the ship feeling during the storm?
- What did Paul say when he saw how worried the men on the ship were?
- Who told Paul that everyone on the ship would survive?
- What happened? Did the men on the ship survive?

Say:

Paul was being held prisoner on a ship that sailed into a huge storm. As the crew was throwing their cargo overboard and worrying for their lives, Paul spoke up to let them know that God would help them survive the storm. Paul was right! Even though their ship crashed into an island, everyone on the ship survived. In the same way, we can survive our storms with God’s help!

Ask/Discuss:

- What are some storms that you could face in your everyday life?
- What storm are you facing in your life today?
- What can you do, as a follower of Jesus, in the midst of the storms in your life?

Pray:

Pray that your children will have strong faith through their storm and that they will always remember that God is always there with them - even in the storm.
