“Go into all the world and preach the Good News to everyone.”
– Mark 16:15



This week, we continue our series called, “Never Forget”. In this series, we are looking at some of the very important things God wants us to always remember.

Read:

Mark 2:1-12

Ask:

- What was wrong with the man in the story?
- Why couldn't he get to Jesus? What did his friends do to help him?

Say:

Most Christians know we are supposed to tell others about Jesus. The sad thing is, many Christians cannot tell you the last time they actually shared their faith with a friend or family member.

Some of the reasons so many Christians do not share their faith is because they are scared, they don't know how, or they don't realize it is their job.

One of the last commands that Jesus gave His followers was to “Go into all the world and make disciples...” If you are a follower of Jesus, then it is your job to make disciples...period!

Ask/Discuss:

- When have you shared your faith recently? Do you find it hard or scary?
- How can you share your faith?

Pray:

Have your child think of the friends they have that need to come to Jesus. Have them pray for those friends out loud by name. Pray that God will give them ideas on how to bring those friends to Jesus.
