“God Is With Me In The Storm”



“God Gives Me Peace In Every Storm!”



“...And the peace I give is a gift that the world cannot give. So don't be troubled or afraid.” – John 14:27b



This week, we continue our series called, “Never Forget”. In this series, we are looking at some of those very important things God wants us to always remember.

Read:

Matthew 8:22-25

Ask:

- Where were Jesus and the disciples in the story?
- Why were the disciples scared? What did Jesus say about the storm?

Say:

In life, we are guaranteed that we will face all kinds of storms - all kinds of trouble. In fact, Jesus said, “In this world, you will have trouble....” We will face many storms in life - storms of different sizes and intensity.

We learn from the Bible Story that Jesus isn't afraid or scared during the storms of life, but instead that He will always be there for us during our storms and He will always take care of us.

When the storms and problems of life come along, we must not look at how HUGE the problems are, but how HUGE the power of God is. We must keep our eyes on Jesus as we are going through life's storms. He will bring us through safely.

Ask/Discuss:

- Have you ever faced a “storm” in your life?
- What can you do when you face a problem in life?

Pray:

Pray for your child if they are facing a storm in their lives. Pray they will remember that Jesus is with them through the storm and remind them He isn't scared at all. Pray that Jesus will protect them and help them make it through the tough storms of life.
