## "I Must Care For Others Like Jesus Would"



"I Will Show Compassion To Everyone!"



"The Lord is good to everyone. He showers compassion on all his creation." - Psalm 145:9



This week, we continue our series called, "Never Forget". You will learn in the Bible Story from a time when Jesus chose to break away from the business of teaching a large crowd to care for two blind beggars.

### Read:

Matthew 20:29-34

### Ask:

- Who was following Jesus as he traveled? What was Jesus doing while walking?
- Who tried to interrupt Jesus' teaching?
- How did the disciples respond to the beggars? How did Jesus respond?

### Say:

The world is full of people - people of all different shapes, sizes, personalities, backgrounds, etc. *(Have your children draw representations of 5 different types of people, one of which is themselves.)* Chances are - you will never find someone exactly like yourself in this world, who likes the same things as you and has all the same opinions and personality traits as you. And chances are - you will find tons of people that are quite the opposite of you.

It's important that, as Christians, we don't get so caught up with those closest to us - our best friends and family, that we forget to care about others. Jesus has time for everyone - and Jesus cares about everyone! And as followers of Jesus, we must care for others like Jesus would!

### Ask/Discuss:

- What are some ways Jesus cares for others?
- What are some ways you can care for others?
- Who are some people you know that need you to show them care?

### Pray:

Pray that your children will creatively and thoughtfully care for others the way Jesus cares for everyone.
