“You & Me, We Agree, We Will Work In Unity!”



“We work together as partners who belong to God.”
- 1 Corinthians 3:9

This week, we continue the series called, “Bugs”. In this lesson, we learn how to work together as partners who belong to God!

Read:

Exodus 17

Ask:

- Who was Moses praying for?
- What happened when Moses would lower his arms?
- When Moses was tired, who helped him to keep his hands up?

Say:

Throughout the church’s history, Christians have struggled to work together in unity. Individuals have strong feelings on how we should go about accomplishing God’s work. Many times, those feelings and ideas differ from one another.

Too often, Christians begin to fight against one another rather than work together in unity. Nothing causes more damage to the Kingdom of God than when the people of God begin to hurt and destroy each other.

God wants His people to work together in unity. We won’t always agree, but when we disagree we should do so in love, trying to compromise with one another.

Ask/Discuss:

- Have you ever gotten in a fight with someone at church?
- How can we be better at working together with other Christians?

Pray:

Pray with your child that they will stay away from fighting other Christians and work together. Pray that God would help you to work together as a family to accomplish the BIG task of reaching the world for Jesus.
