"Get Off The Floor And Learn To Soar!"



"...anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person. The old life has gone; a new life has begun!" - 2 Corinthians 5:17

This week, we continue the series called, "Bugs". In this lesson, we learn from the caterpillar and the butterfly. We learn that when we let Jesus transform our lives, we can rise above sin and reach the potential God has for our lives.

Read:

Acts 9:1-19

Ask:

- What was Saul known for?
- What happened when he was on the road to Damascas?
- What happened when Ananias prayed for Saul? Who did Saul become?

Say:

Each person who has accepted Jesus as his or her Lord and Savior is a brand new person. The old person who used to sin and do things that broke God's heart is gone. The new person who is living under the obedience of Christ is now alive.

Just as the caterpillar crawls on the ground, limited in its ability to soar, so our lives without Jesus can never reach the great heights that God has planned for us.

Ask/Discuss:

- What happens when you try to do life without Jesus?
- How have you changed since having Jesus in your life?

Prav:

Lead your child in a prayer of repentance for their sins. Pray that God would send His power to change us on the inside, forgive us of our sins, and help us to soar to new heights as brand new people, changed by His power!
