Read:

2 Kings 4:1-7

Ask:

- Why did the woman need money?
- What was the only thing the woman had in her house?

- What did the woman do with the oil in her jar? When did the oil run out?

Say:

Very often, we sell ourselves short. We begin to compare ourselves to others - our talent, our abilities, our money, our family - and we convince ourselves that we have very little to offer God.
