Read:
2 Kings 6:8-23

- Ask:**
- What happened when the King of Aram tried to invade the territories of Israel? Who told Elisha the plans?
 - What did the King of Aram decide to do when he found out Elisha was sharing all of their battle plans with the King of Israel?
 - How did Elisha’s servant respond when he saw the armies of Aram had arrived to kill Elisha? How did Elisha respond?
 - What did Elisha pray and what happened as a result?

Say:
It is easy to get discouraged by what we see or don’t see. We often look in front of us and only see problems, sickness, and defeat. We focus on the problems we DO see and rarely focus on the solution we DON’T see. When we don’t always physically see how God is working on our behalf, we tend to forget He is always there fighting on our behalf.

- Ask/Discuss:**
- Are there times in your life when you wonder if God is really there for you?
 - What should you do when you feel that way?

Pray:
Ask your children if they have been struggling with feeling like God is not there. Pray that God will open their eyes to see that He is not only there for them, but He is working to bring the victory for them!
