“...You must love the LORD your God with all of your heart, all your soul, and all your mind.” - Matthew 22:37

This week, we finish the series called, “Ouch!”. This week, we learn from the parable of the two builders. We learn what it means to follow Jesus with all of our heart.

Read:

Matthew 7:24-27

Ask:

- Where did the wise man build his house? Where did the foolish man build his house?
- What happened to their houses when the storm came?
- To whom did Jesus compare the wise man? To whom did He compare the foolish man?

Say:

To be a Christian means that we follow Jesus and we live our life for Him daily. Unfortunately, many people are confused about this. They think that as long as long as they go to church, do some good deeds, and CLAIM to be a Christian, then that means they are going to Heaven.

Jesus taught that it takes much more than that. In order to go to Heaven, we must receive His forgiveness for our sin and have a relationship with Him.

Ask/Discuss:

- Do you see yourself as the wise man or the foolish man from the story?
- What does it mean to you to follow Jesus? Are you living like that in your life?

Pray:

Ask you child if they want to ask Jesus to be their Savior if they haven't already. Pray with them to receive forgiveness of their sins. Celebrate their brand new life in Jesus! Pray that they will follow Jesus closely and do what He leads them to do.
